- The Student Will Gain In-depth Experience In The Management Of Gyn Patients In Private Office Settings.
- The Student Will Further Develop Basic Clinical Skills Related To The Care Of Female Patients.
- The Student Will Have Exposure To Common Gynecological Problems Both Surgical And Non-surgical.
- The Student Will Gain Experience In The Total Care Of Postpartum Patients.
- The Student Will Observe Specialized Gyn Procedures, as available.

DESCRIPTION:

Additional exposure to Gynecology in the preceptor mode. Participation in outpatient gynecology and inpatient care including surgery. Some call may be required. This is a clinical experience in which the student will follow a specific preceptor in the private office and/or hospital clinic setting. Students have the opportunity to observe specialized Gyn procedures and to learn about private practice by working directly with an Ob/Gyn Practitioner.

EVALUATION:

Required: Written or oral presentation on topic agreed upon between supervising physician and student. Preceptor(S) Will Be Asked To Submit A Written Evaluation At The Conclusion Of The Clerkship. Faculty Are Encouraged To Provide Ongoing Feedback Throughout Elective Rotations.
