

Releasing Test Results to MyMichigan

When patients have tests performed at MidMichigan Health’s facilities, they may receive their results electronically in their MyMidMichigan account. The table below shows when results will automatically release to the patient portal, whether or not the ordering provider has reviewed them. This schedule, adopted from the University of Michigan’s practices, is designed to meet patient needs and meaningful use guidelines while giving providers sufficient time to contact patients and discuss more sensitive results. If desired, providers may release results earlier than the scheduled date by manually sending them via the portal or mail.
