OBJECTIVES:

1. Emphasis will be on the primary care aspects of sports medicine.
2. The student will be exposed to the care of acute and chronic sports injuries.
3. The student will be exposed to sports injury evaluation, treatment and preventive care of athletes of all levels and ages.
4. The student will become proficient in the evaluation/physical exam skills for new patients with sports related injuries.
5. The student will understand the use of laboratory and imaging data as it relates to diagnosis and care of sports injuries.
6. The student will know the commonly used treatment modalities of common sports injuries.
7. Students will be exposed to common procedures used in Sports Medicine.
8. The student will be expected to attend local physician covered sporting events.

DESCRIPTION:

The student will actively participate in the evaluation and management of patients with Sports Medicine problems. Emphasis will be placed on learning through active participation in diagnosis, exam and treatment of common Sports Medicine injuries.

EVALUATION:

Preceptor(s) will be asked to submit a written evaluation at the conclusion of the clerkship. Faculty are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback throughout elective rotations.
