Hematology/Oncology

DESCRIPTION:

This elective offers the student an opportunity to evaluate and manage patients with hematologic or oncologic disorders. Students will learn the approach to the comprehensive management of the cancer patient with multiple medical problems. Students will be responsible for taking the history and physical examination, collecting and assimilating laboratory and diagnostic study data and formulating recommendations for further diagnostic work-ups and therapy. Students will spend time in the in-patient and out-patient settings. Students will attend appropriate conferences in the hospital during the clerkship.

EVALUATION:

Preceptor(s) will be asked to submit a written evaluation at the conclusion of the clerkship. Evaluation will be based upon clinical performance ratings from supervising physicians. Faculty are encouraged to provide ongoing feedback throughout elective rotations.
